Dear Friends,

In celebration of the 100th anniversaries of the cities of Harlingen and San Benito, Simmons Oak Farms will be donating 100 live oak trees to schools, churches, not-for-profits, and government agencies within those cities.

Your organization can apply for a specific number of live oak trees, *Quercus virginiana*. These live oaks will range in size from 2" caliper (or approximately 12' tall) to 5" caliper (or approximately 18' tall). The larger items may require professional installation. Winners will be responsible for properly planting, staking, and watering the trees. Simmons Oak Farms will provide information to you or your installers about how to properly install and stake your new trees. Valley Proud has designated February as All Valley Arbor Month. Winners are expected to install their trees during the month of February.

How do you get them? Just complete the enclosed application and return it to us before January 15th. You will be notified by February 1st if your organization has been chosen.
